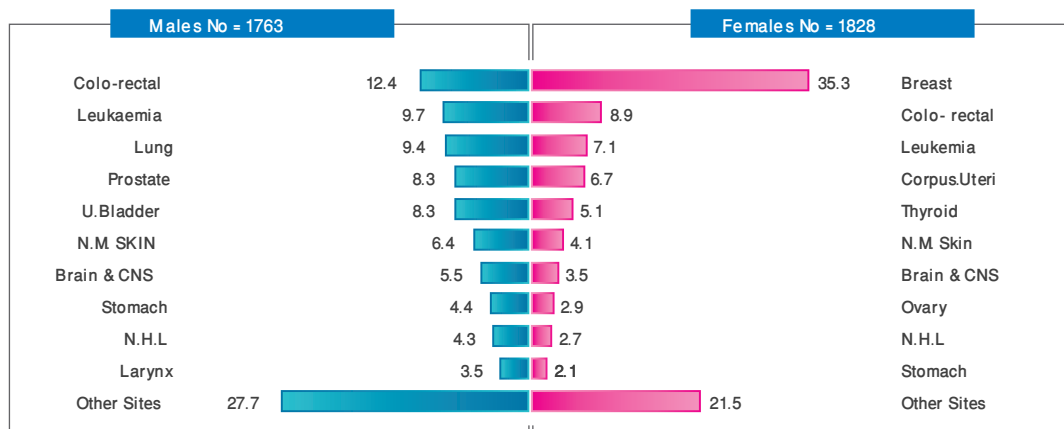


JORDAN CANCER STATISTICS 2004

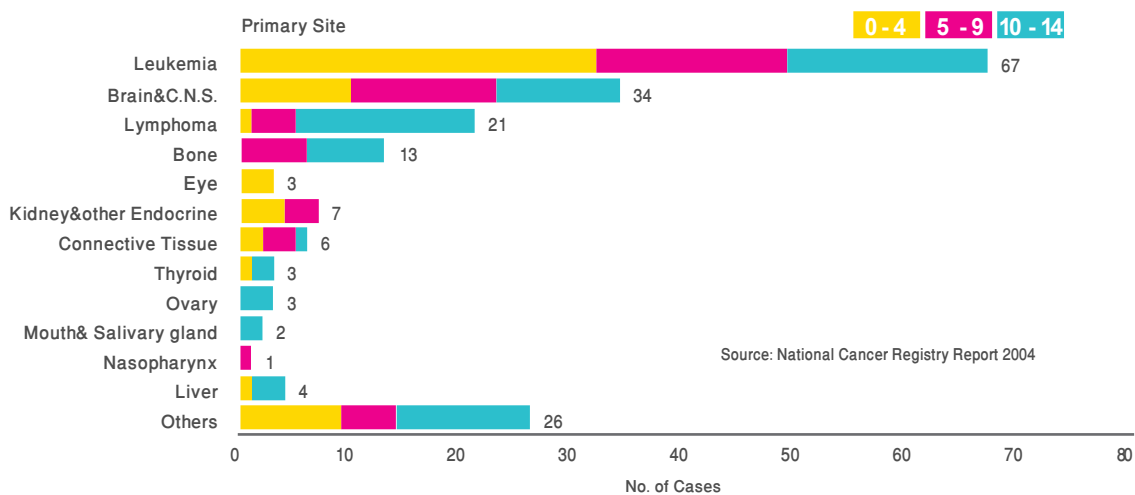
- Cancer is the second cause of death in Jordan after heart diseases.
- 3,591 new cancer cases were registered among Jordanians in 2004: 1763 males (49.1%) and 1828 females (50.9%).
- 742 Non-Jordanians registered cases, accounting for (17.1 %) of all registered cases (Jordanians and non-Jordanians- 4333)
- 175 children between 0-18 years of age were diagnosed with cancer.

MOST PREVALENT CANCERS AFFECTING JORDANIANS

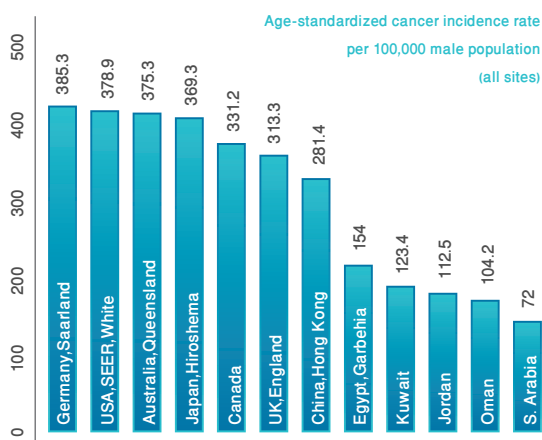

DISTRIBUTION OF CHILDHOOD CANCER BY AGE GROUP AND PRIMARY SITE

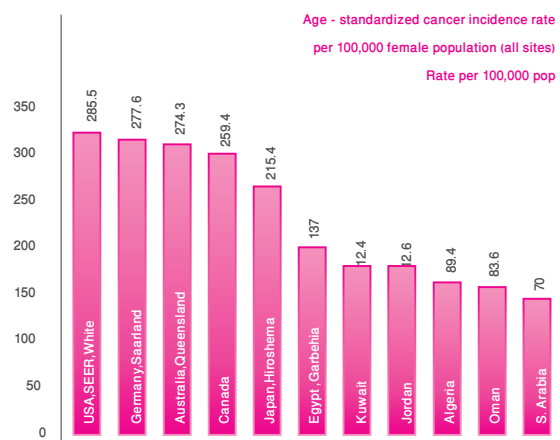
